### **OBJECTIVES**

This course, jointly organized by the Confucius Institute of the University of Lisbon and the Macau Scientific and Cultural Centre, aims at providing the basic skills for playing the *guzheng*, a traditional Chinese musical instrument. During this course, we plan to teach our students about the aesthetics and history of Chinese music, as well as *guzheng* musical notation and theory.

Classes will be individual, so as to meet each student's needs and thus facilitate the learning process of the presented techniques.

At the end of the course, students are expected to have acquired the basic *guzheng* techniques and to be able to play simple pieces, in groups. The course will end with a small performance.

The course will begin on the 16<sup>th</sup> March, with an open class, free of charge, at the end of which last enrollments will be accepted.
